**PETITION TO THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT FOR OUR COMPLAINT
FOR \$60 MILLION QATARGATE AND BORREL**

On Sunday, December 18, 2022, the Denunciators of Judicial Authoritarianism alliance registered a petition in the European Parliament for the European Commission to check the bank details of the \$60 million Qatargate, as well as the money laundering of Borrel, other European officials and Spanish officials, all of whom were reported to the European Commission in 2021 and 2022.

The following day, the European Parliament's Committee on Petitions admitted this petition for processing under the number 1161/2022. This is the first time that a petition has been registered on the first working day, which indicates the importance that the European Parliament attaches to this petition. Several MEPs are aware that the European Commission is processing a criminal complaint by the Alliance against the Spanish governments presided by Pedro Sánchez (2018-2022).

In the complaints, the Alliance always provides the investigation with complete banking information, so that the competent bodies of the European Commission: OLAF and the European Public Prosecutor's Office, only have to verify that the banking information is correct. However, these two bodies and the General Secretariat of the European Commission itself, systematically cover up these complaints. It is conceivable that they check the bank accounts and then decide to cover it up because of the scandal of the reported corruption.

The petition is titled: DENUNCIATION 60 MILLION QATARGATE AND BORREL and what is requested is the following:

1.- On 16.12.2022 we have denounced 60 million that the 7 known implicated in the QATARGATE collected, recalling that José Borrel, Vice-President of the European Commission has collected to benefit a financial group of Americans. In some cases, all the banking documentation was provided. The complaint is attached.

2.- We have an open appeal in the European Commission because OLAF, including its Director General, has covered up three of our complaints against Spain for appointing corrupt politicians and judges to positions in the European Commission. In the three complaints (21.02.2022, 12.04.2022 and 21.04.2022) we provided the bank documentation.

In the aforementioned complaint of 21.02.2022, we denounced the European Public Prosecutor's Office for covering up the corruption of several public officials, some of whom are retired. The European Commission has not pronounced itself on this complaint.

We call on the European Parliament to demand that the European Commission follow up on our complaints and to oblige OLAF and the European Public Prosecutor's Office to verify the money laundering reported.

In the above press release we provided the full banking information on the \$60 million Qatargate and Borrel's (Vice-President of the European Commission) money laundering.
