**AMPLIFYING COMPLAINT AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT OF SPAIN  
TO THE SUPREME COURT AND THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION**

On January 27, 2023, the alliance Denunciantes del Autoritarismo Judicial (Denouncers of Judicial Authoritarianism) has filed an amplifying complaint against the Government, to the Supreme Court and to the European Commission.

The previous complaint was sent on 11.11.2022 and the European Commission processed it on 25.11.2022, after its registration as Ares(2022)8174536, in Unit F.3 - Economies of the Member States I (Croatia, Spain) of the Directorate General for Economic and Financial Affairs of the European Commission". This is an unprecedented event because never before has the European Commission investigated a complaint against a government.

The Supreme Court has not even notified its registration and initiation yet.

The complaint requests that all the governments of the member countries of the European Union be offered the opportunity to appear as injured parties, establishing a new way of control of the Government.

In this amplifying complaint, the crimes derived from several appointments of ministers, of magistrates in the Constitutional Court, of the Attorney General of the State, of the president of the Council of State and of the President of the CIS are denounced.

It denounces the lack of renewal of the General Council of the Judiciary and the impulse of the Government and Parliament to common and institutional criminality, as well as the criminalization of judges.

The legislative and executive corruption in the European funds is also denounced. Crimes related to the transposition of European Union directives are denounced, both in their approval and in the coercion of the Parliament and other institutions for their illegal approval, with usurpation of the Government.

More documentary falsehoods are denounced, in royal decrees, in unemployment data and in data on Social Security affiliates.

We denounce the enrichment by non-refundable subsidies for the financing of the

acquisition of housing for what the Government calls social renting.

The lack of transparency of the Government is also denounced, which is a proof of the evidence of the Government's criminality. There has never been a Government with so much opacity.

It is denounced that the Parliament has not complied with the law, exercising its mandatory control over the Government, allowing the corruption and totalitarianism of the latter.

The last chapter relates the embezzlement towards the Catalans.

In addition to the members of the Government, the following high officials are denounced: Mercedes Cabrera Orejas as General Director of Relations with the Courts (DGRC), Rafael Simancas Simancas as Secretary of State for Relations with the Courts and Constitutional Affairs, Meritxell Batet Lamana as President of the Congress of Deputies, Laura Díez Bueso as General Director of Constitutional Affairs and Legal Coordination of the Ministry of Presidency and as Magistrate of the Constitutional Court, Juan Carlos Campo Moreno as Magistrate of the Constitutional Court, as well as a member of the Government, Dolores Delgado García as Attorney General of the State, Jaume Asens Llodrá, Member of Congress, and José Félix Tezanos Tortajada, Director of the Center for Sociological Research (CIS).

Like the previous complaint, this extension has been sent with a visible copy to dozens of Members of Congress, who have also been informed of the investigation in the European Commission of the previous complaint.

We also refer to the recent proceedings in the Plenary of the European Parliament against the Spanish Government.
