



## **PRESS RELEASE – 12.04.2022**

### **COMPLAINT AGAINST BORREL AND OTHER PSOE APPOINTMENTS IN THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION**

Since December 2021, Javier Marzal, promoter of the alliance Denouncers of Judicial Authoritarianism, has filed five complaints with the European Public Prosecutor's Office and five other complaints with the European Commission, against the metamafia of José María Mena Álvarez (Catalan Chief Prosecutor 1996-2006) for numerous criminal actions and against other criminals linked to the PSOE.

Today we have extended our complaint against Spain before the European Commission of 21.02.2022, also based on the documentation of the Royuela Dossier, because José Borrel Fontelles and Judge Elisabeth Castello Fontova do not meet the European standards to be able to be an official of the European Union, specifically Article 27 of the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union which states that: "The provision of posts shall aim to secure for the institution the services of officials possessing the highest standards of competence, performance and integrity".

In addition, the judge appointed to Eurojust, violates Article 65.1 of REGULATION (EU) 2018/1727 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 14 November 2018 on the European Union Agency for Criminal Judicial Cooperation (Eurojust), which refers to the aforementioned Staff Regulations for EU officials.

Logically, people who hide millions from the tax authorities do not have a minimum of integrity, especially when they have a criminal provenance.

Borrel was denounced for not declaring 6,000,000USD and the denunciation has been extended to 59 million (between euros and US dollars), providing all the numbers of the bank deposits, the date of their opening, the office and the bank.

In addition, the undeclared amounts of the following former Spanish PSOE ministers and European officials are extended: Enrique Baron

Crespo, from \$27 million to \$80 million; Pascual Maragall Mira from \$152 million to \$167 million and Joaquin Almunia Amann's \$27 million are maintained.

Former Minister Javier Solana Madariaga is added with \$80 million, who was the EU High Representative for Foreign Affairs and Security, a position currently held by Borrel.

As for Felipe González Márquez, President of the Government of Spain 1982-1996, it is extended from 184.2 million to 290.2 million, part in euros and part in US dollars.

The complaint states that, "All of the above is necessary to know in order to understand the causes why corruption in Spain reached 8% of GDP (Eurostat 2018). In this situation of systemic corruption, we ask you for a meeting in Spain, without the attendance of Spanish or European public authorities representing Spain, which will be attended by Miguel Bernad, Secretary General of Manos Limpias, Santiago Royuela, some member of the alliance Denunciantes del Autoritarismo Judicial and, possibly, Judge Fernando Presencia".

Today, Voz Populi reports that: "The PSOE recovers Javier Solana to raise the image of Pedro Sánchez", the same day he is denounced in the European Commission for laundering 80 million.

It is hard to believe that the current PSOE is not aware of the tax denouncements for more than 5,260 million made by Alberto Royuela Fernández and the journalist Juan Martínez Grasa in 2004, which include all those mentioned above. It should be added that the Tax Agency denounced them, being processed by the Central Court of Instruction No. 5 of the Audiencia Nacional, where Judge Baltasar Garzón was the head judge.

The complaint has been sent in English to avoid it being manipulated by Spaniards who are European civil servants.
